<p>Once Fall 2013 grades are posted, students that tested into Math 12 and passed with an 'A' will be offered the opportunity to retest. The hope is that students will test into a much higher level math, thus preventing them from having to take so many math courses. The data will be reviewed to determine:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If students do actually test into a higher level math • If students will take advantage of the retesting option • If the information received in their Math 12 class helped to improve their skill level 	<p><u>Results:</u> Each semester an email will be sent inviting students that passed Math 12 with an 'A' to retest. The Math 12 instructors will also be asked to advise students of this opportunity. The Assessment Center will track the test results of these students to determine their new test score increased and if they tested into a higher level math course.</p>
