

## Steps to Register/Matriculate

1.	Apply for Admission and Obtain a Student ID Number
	<ul> <li>Apply online at <u>www.compton.edu</u> and click on <u>Apply Online</u>.</li> </ul>
	• Receive a Student ID number via email 48 to 72 hours after submitting your application.
	<ul> <li>Check your <u>MyECC</u> account for your appointment date and time.</li> </ul>
2.	Attend the New Student Orientation
	<ul> <li>Purchase a parking decal at a parking kiosk any time you park on campus.</li> </ul>
	• Sign-up for a New Student Orientation in the Counseling Department, located in the Administration building or call (310) 900-1600, Ext. 2076. At sign-up, students will receive an educational planning guide, a copy of the Steps to Register/Matriculate, and a campus map. At orientation, student will receive a study guide for the assessment test.
	<ul> <li>New Student Orientations take place in the Welcome Center classroom (D-27).</li> </ul>
3.	Take the Assessment Test (English/ESL & Math)
	Prior to taking the assessment test, you must attend a New Student Orientation.
	<ul> <li>Bring your Student ID number, a photo ID (i.e. CA DL or High School ID), and your MyECC (<a href="http://myecc.elcamino.edu">http://myecc.elcamino.edu</a>) username and password to the assessment test.</li> <li>Assessment Center is located in Room D-26, (310) 900-1600, Ext. 2830.</li> </ul>
4.	Meet with a Counselor to Develop an Educational Plan
