## Steps for Matriculation

## 1. Apply for Admission and Obtain a Student ID Number.

You will be provided a Student ID number via email 48 to 72 hours after submitting your application.

- Apply online at <u>www.compton.edu</u> and click on <u>Apply Online</u>.
- Students will receive an appointment date and time in their <u>MyECC</u> account.
- Students are strongly encouraged to purchase a parking decal at the Bursars Office (C-36).

### 2. Attend the New Student Orientation in D-29 Welcome Center.

- Sign-up for New Student Orientation in the Counseling Department, located in the Administration building or call (310) 900-1600, Ext. 2076.
- Student will receive a study guide for the assessment test.
- Students will complete an educational planning guide.
- Students will receive a map of the campus.

### 3. Take the Assessment Test (English & Math)

You will need your Student ID number and a photo ID to take the assessment test. Also, students should obtain their <u>MyECC</u> (<u>http://myecc.elcamino.edu</u>) username and password before taking the assessment test.

#### 4. Meet with a Counselor to Develop an Educational Plan

You will need your Student ID number and the last four digits of your social security number (If you choose not to disclose your social security number on the online application, you will be given a temporary social security number).


