Compton College participates in The Learning-Aligned Employment Program (LAEP). This offers eligible students the opportunity to earn money to help defray their educational costs while gaining education-aligned, career-related employment. Student employment affords students with an opportunity to work on or off campus and earn money to supplement expenses not covered by grants or loans. Funds are awarded to eligible students through the Financial Aid Office. Student employment does not affect grant awards; however, in some cases, it may reduce the amount of student loans that students may borrow. Additionally, a student will only be awarded one employment program. - Must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid ([FAFSA](#)) or a CA [DREAM Act](#) Application.
- Must meet all the requirements for federal and state student aid including all [Satisfactory Academic Progress](#) requirements.
- Must have a 2022-23 Award letter; however, not all students who receive an award letter are eligible for an award.
- Must demonstrate financial need.
- Must be enrolled in at six (6) units for the Fall and Spring semesters.
