The Federal Work Study Program provides on-campus jobs for undergraduate students with financial need, allowing them to earn money to help pay for education expenses. Your hourly pay will be at least the current federal minimum wage but may be higher depending on the type of work you do. Your total Work Study award depends on when you apply, your level of need, and the funding level of your school. To be eligible, you must qualify for a Pell Grant, be enrolled in at least 6 units, and must be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).
