Gas Leak Reported – Heating and Hot Water Affected on South End of Campus

On Wednesday, February 15, 2023, at approximately 12:00 p.m., a gas leak was reported on the exterior northeast side of the Y-Building, south of the Tartar Statue. **No evacuations were necessary.**

For safety, the Gas Company turned off the valve that provides gas for boilers and water, which affects the domestic hot water and comfort heating for the Library-Student Success Center, Math/Science Building, Vocational Technology Building, and buildings U, V, W and Y.

Classes have not been canceled in those buildings. Individual instructors teaching in those buildings may determine whether the temperature is unbearable and if students should be sent home.

The plumbing vendor will be onsite tomorrow, February 16, 2023, to locate and repair the gas leak. More updates to follow.
