To minimize the number of students on campus and increase social distancing, *Compton College will move the majority of courses to alternative methods of instruction, such as Canvas and Zoom, **beginning Saturday, March 21 through Friday, April 10, 2020.***

Certain courses, such as labs and physical education courses, that cannot be conducted online have been canceled for the remainder of the spring semester.

- Spring break is scheduled for April 11 through April 17, 2020 – no classes in session
