July 2017	Establish El Camino College/ Compton College Transition Planning Team and schedule monthly meetings.
December 2017	Prepare Draft Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution.
February 2018	Review Draft of Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution document at the Compton College Accreditation Steering Committee meeting.
March 2018	Review Draft of Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution document at the El Camino College/ Compton College Transition Planning Committee meeting. Revise the Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution document.
April 2018	Post draft of the Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution document on El Camino College and Compton College website. Host Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution forums at Compton College.
May 2018	Complete consultation process for Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution document.
June 2018	Final editing of Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution document.

Submit the Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution to El Camino Community College District and Compton Community College District Board of Trustees for first reading.

July 2018

El Camino Community College District and Compton Community College District Board of Trustees receive for second reading and approval the Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution document.

Substantive Change Proposal – Change in Control of Institution copied and submit to ACCJC.
