The Outreach Office is also using the social media, such as Facebook and MySpace, to recruit students, and staff are also appearing and speaking at local schools and churches.

He indicated that our outreach efforts were more successful in some parts of our region than others. He mentioned Paramount as an area that required greater outreach effort.
