Students may also register online anytime by going to www.compton.edu and clicking on *MyECC*, or by calling 310-516-9339. Computers are available for student use in the Welcome Center, Financial Aid Lab, Admissions and Records Office, VT 209 and Library. Students must have a registration appointment prior to going online or calling to register. Go to www.compton.edu and click on *MyECC – Registration Appointment Time* or call 310-516-9339 to confirm individual registration dates and times.

Need Cash for College? Attend This Workshop

Students may qualify for up to \$5,550 in Federal grants. The first step is to apply for financial aid by filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>. To help students with the application process, El Camino College Compton Center is hosting a free **“Cash for College” Workshop on Saturday, February 20**, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the Vocational Technology Building. Students are encouraged to apply for financial aid, even if they think they may not be eligible. Many people are unaware they meet the requirements to receive financial aid. In many cases, financial aid can fully cover enrollment fees, as well as books and supplies. The deadline to apply for Cal Grants is March 2, 2010.
