Public Invited to Virtual Meeting of Compton Community College District Redistricting Committee on February 3

Community Member Feedback Needed on Proposed Trustee Area Boundary Maps

The Compton Community College District (CCCD) Redistricting Committee will hold its final meeting on Thursday, February 3, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. All committee meetings are open to the public and take place via Zoom; meeting access information is available online:

Members of the public are encouraged to attend the virtual meeting to provide input, and may also review the proposed redistricting maps for the CCCD Trustee Area boundaries on the district website at: https://compton.edu/district/district_information/district-redistricting.aspx.

The Compton Community College District, along with many other public agencies and school districts in California, has begun a process to review and modify its elected trustee area boundaries. Every 10 years, local community colleges, city councils and other local agencies must adjust their elected trustee area boundaries to equalize the population. How and where district boundaries are drawn can shape communities' ability to elect the representatives of their choice.

Governing Boards of community college districts are required, by the end of February 28, 2022, to adjust the boundaries of any or all trustee areas by using census population figures from the U.S. Department of Commerce's Census Bureau decennial census of the country's population conducted in 2020 and validated by the Population Research Unit of the California Department of Finance.
