- 2) Resolution 06-27-2022G was Board Approved
  - a) The Tartar mascot shall be retired effective July 1, 2025.
    - i. Effective 2025-2026 season, starting with football, m/w soccer, and x-country
    - ii. Phase out completed by June 30, 2025.
  - b) Upon adoption of the new mascot, the Administration may retire the Tartar mascot for some or all purposes on such earlier date(s) as are determined feasible by the Administration.
  - i. Phase out would begin campuswide with 2023-2024 year (starting July 1, 2023) for everyone except Athletics.
  - c) In order to honor and celebrate Compton College without objectifying any person or group, the Administration shall obtain input from students, faculty, staff, alumni, and community members in order to identify recommendations for a new mascot.
  - d) Recommendation(s) for a new mascot shall be presented to the Board of Trustees for approval, with the goal of adopting a new mascot by the end of the 2022-2023 academic year [June 30, 2023].
