The District is committed to and responsible for a safe and healthy learning environment. Every person is encouraged to become an “energy saver”.

The District uses the energy conservation/efficiency requirements of Title 24, Part 6, California Energy Code, for its projects. The President/Chief Executive Officer or designee is responsible for carrying out its enforcement. District policy requires sustainable building design and clean energy standards. Responsible design professionals, as selected by the District, are required to submit specific certification (as required by the California Energy Code) to the required agencies for inclusion in the permanent project record documents file. Copies of the Title 24 compliance forms for both residential and nonresidential construction are available online.

Energy conservation is a part of the goals and objectives recommended in Compton College’s Comprehensive Master Plan.
