AR 5220 Shower Facilities for Homeless Students Issued: May 16, 2017

The District maintains shower facilities for student use on campus. Shower facilities are located at Men's Locker Room (Building W) and Women's Locker Room (Building U) and are open from 8:00 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. Monday-Friday, when campus is open to the public. Showers may be used by any homeless student who is actively enrolled in at least one course, has paid enrollment fees, and is in good standing with the district.

A student in good standing does not have restrictions from contact with specified individuals, college activities, services, offices, or designated areas for violating any Student Discipline Procedures per Administrative Regulation 5520.

A homeless student is defined as a student who does not have a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This includes, but is not limited to, students who: are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.
