BP 2200 Board Duties and Responsibilities

Issued: January 19, 2010 Amended: November 16, 2010

Reference: Accreditation Standard IVB.1.d

The Board of Trustees carries out its responsibilities on behalf of the citizens of the Compton Community College District in accordance with the authority granted and duties defined in Education Code Section 70902 as modified by A.B. 318.

The Board is committed to fulfilling its responsibilities to:

- Advocate for and protect the district;
- Assist in establishing a climate in which high standards are maintained and institutional goals are accomplished;
- Conduct itself in legal, ethical, and prudent ways;
- Advise the Special Trustee in carrying out the authority delegated to him by the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges pursuant to Education Code Section 71093;
- Respect the authority of district's Chief Executive Officer to manage the day-to-day affairs of
 the district and to oversee the work of district personnel in the appropriate performance of
 their duties by providing direction and guidance only to the CEO; and
- Support the partnership with El Camino College and promote its success.

This policy shall become effective immediately upon approval but shall be repealed automatically on July 1, 2011, unless the Board and Special Trustee act before that date to readopt the policy in the same or modified form.
