BP 2432 President/CEO Succession

The Board delegates authority to the President/CEO to appoint an acting President/CEO to serve in his or her absence for short periods of time, not to exceed twenty-eight (28) calendar days at a time.

In the absence of the President/CEO and when an acting President/CEO has not been named, administrative responsibility shall reside with the Vice President of Administrative Services:

The Board shall appoint an acting President/CEO for periods exceeding twenty-eight (28) calendar days.

If necessary, the Board President shall schedule a special board meeting to do so. If necessary, an acting President/CEO will serve until the Board of Trustees meets.

The District Human Resource Staffing Plan shall include Succession Planning Strategies, Building Internal Capacity, and Analysis of the College's Leadership needs.
