BP 3720 Computer and Network Use

References: Education Code Section 70902; Government Code Section 3543.1(b); Penal Code Section 502; Cal. Const., Art. 1 Section 1; 17 U.S. Code Sections 101 et seq.;

The District owns, leases, and/or operates a variety of computer and communication systems, including but not limited to, voicemail, electronic mail (e-mail), telephone, and access to the internet, which are provided for the use of District faculty, administrators, staff, and students (hereafter referred to as employees and students) in support of the programs of the college and District. Hereinafter, this system and all of its component parts shall be referred to as the "District Network."

Employees and students who use District computers and networks and the information they contain, and related resources are required to use these resources responsibly. The President/Chief Executive Officer (CEO) shall establish procedures that provide guidelines to students and employees for the appropriate use of information technologies. The procedures shall include that users must respect software copyrights and licenses, respect the integrity of computer-based information resources, refrain from seeking to gain unauthorized access, and respect the rights of other computer users.

Students who do not observe the requirements of this Policy may be in violation of the Student Code of Conduct and subject to student discipline. Employees who do not observe the requirements of this Policy may be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.
