BP 4260 Prerequisites and Corequisites

Title 5 Sections 55000 and 55003

The President/Chief Executive Officer (CEO) is authorized to establish prerequisites, corequisites, and advisories on recommended preparation for courses in the curriculum in collegial consultation with the Academic Senate. All such prerequisites, corequisites, and advisories shall be established in accordance with the standards set out in Title 5. Any prerequisites, corequisites, or advisories shall be necessary and appropriate for achieving the purpose for which they are established. The procedures shall include a way in which prerequisites or corequisites may be challenged by a student on grounds permitted by law. Prerequisites, corequisites, and advisories shall be identified in District publications available to students.

The President/CEO shall, in collegial consultation with the Academic Senate, develop and submit to the Board for approval procedures to assure that the policy is implemented according to the standards set forth in Title 5.
