Board Policy 6740 – Citizens' Oversight Committee

The President/Chief Executive Officer (CEO) directs that the following regulations apply to the Citizen's Oversight Committee at the Compton Community College District:

- I. **Membership.** The committee shall consist of at least seven (7) members to serve for a term of two (2) years and for no more than two (2) consecutive terms. Members shall serve without compensation. The committee shall be comprised of at least:
  - A. One member active in a business organization representing the business community located within the district;
  - B. One member who is a resident of the district and active in a senior citizen's organization;
  - C. One member who is a resident of the district and active in a bona fide taxpayer's organization;
  - D. One member enrolled as a Compton College student and active in a campus group. The student may serve up to six (6) months after his or her status as a student at the Compton College ends;
  - E. One member active in an organization supporting the district such as the foundation.
- II. **Membership exclusion.** No employee, official, contractor, consultant, or vendor of Compton Community College District shall be appointed to, or serve on, the committee. No elected official shall be appointed to, or serve on, the committee.

### **III. Meetings, Minutes and Records.**

- A. All meetings of the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall be open to the public as specified in the Ralph M. Brown Act.
  
- B. If the committee does not adopt an annual calendar of meetings, it shall adopt a schedule of meetings at least once every six months for the following six-month period.
  
- C. A quorum of the committee shall consist of any four members plus the President/CEO or his or her designee.
  
- D. Minutes of the proceedings of the committee, all documents received by the committee and all reports issued by the committee are public records which, to the extent the President/CEO or his or her designee deems feasible, will be made available on a website maintained by the District.
