

Multi-Factor Authentication Setup (using Microsoft Authenticator)



On your mobile device:

Step1: Download and install the Microsoft Authenticator app to your smartphone from Apple Store or Google Play before proceeding.



On your computer:

Step2: If you logged in to MyCompton, log out and log in to the MyCompton portal.

Step 3: You will receive a message, “**More information required,**” on your screen. Click **Next**.

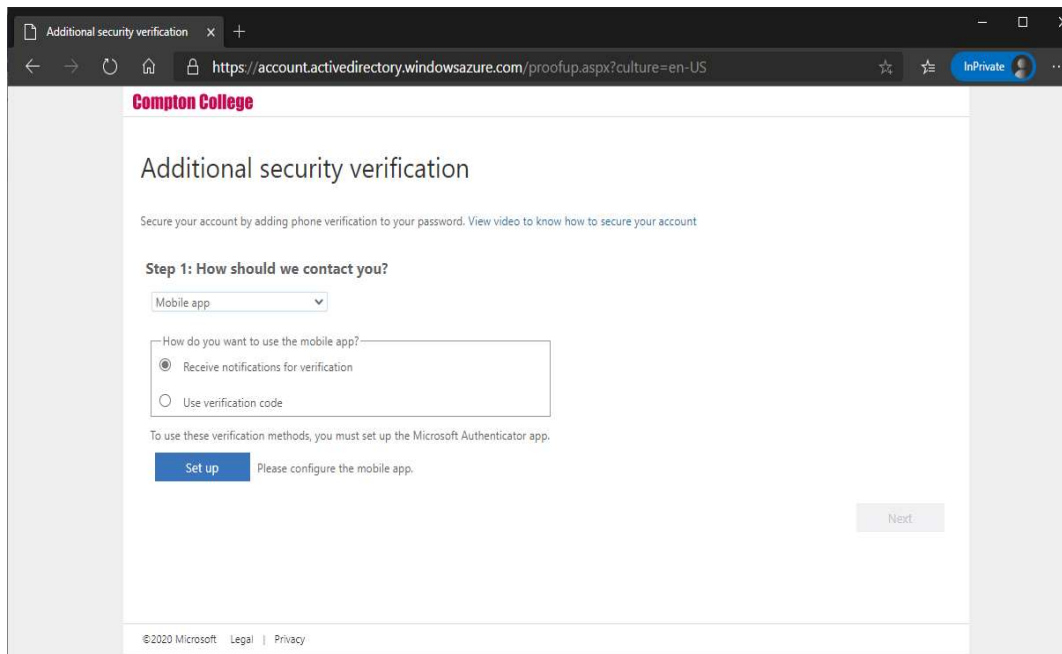

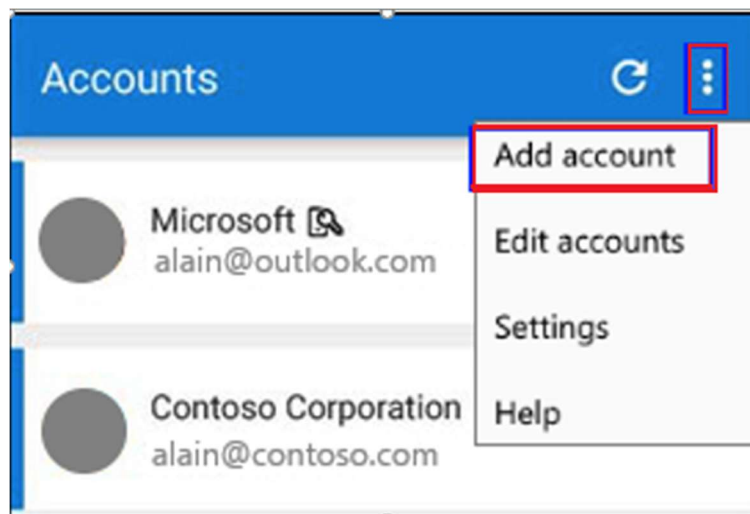
Step 4: Select “**Mobile App**” from the drop-down menu.

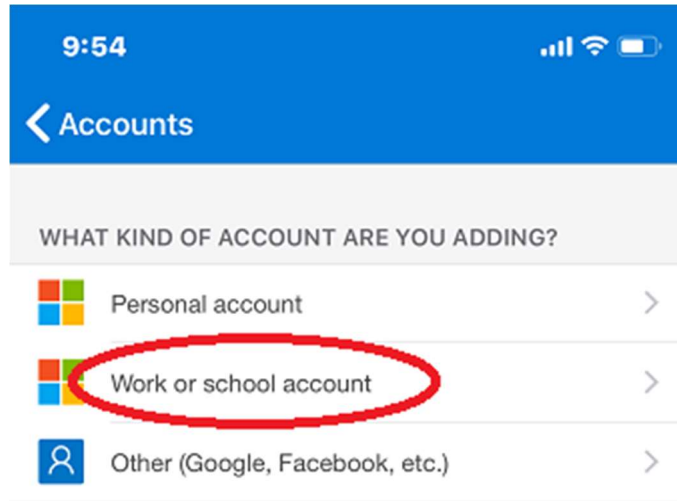
Step 5: Select “**Receive notification for verification,**” click **Set up**.



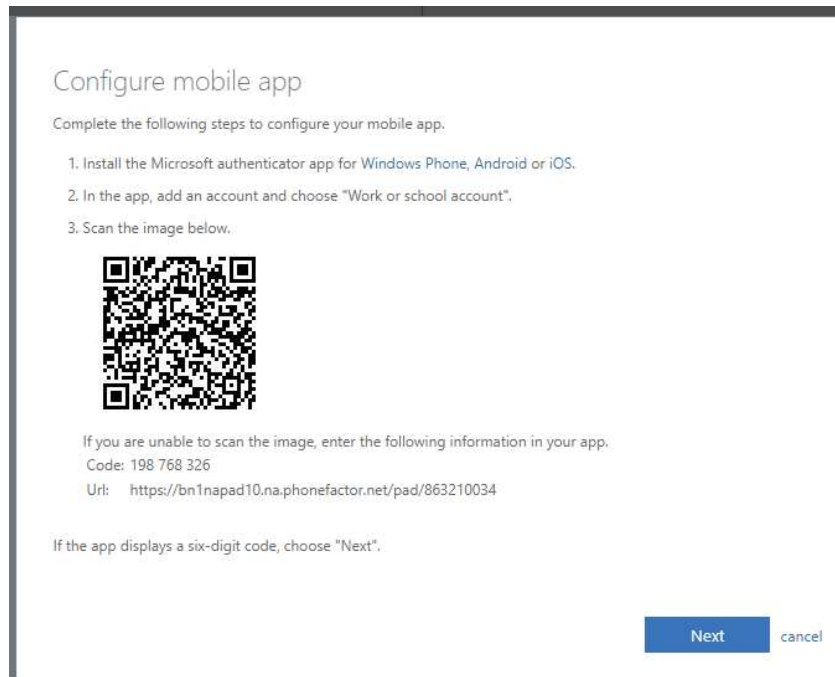
On your mobile device:

Step 6: Select “**Add an account**” and choose “**Work or school account.**” Then click **Scan QR code**.





Step 7: Scan the QR code on your computer, click **Next**



Step 8: On the mobile app, click the **Compton College** account

Step 9: Click **Sign in** without a password, click **Continue**.

Step 10: Click **Approve**

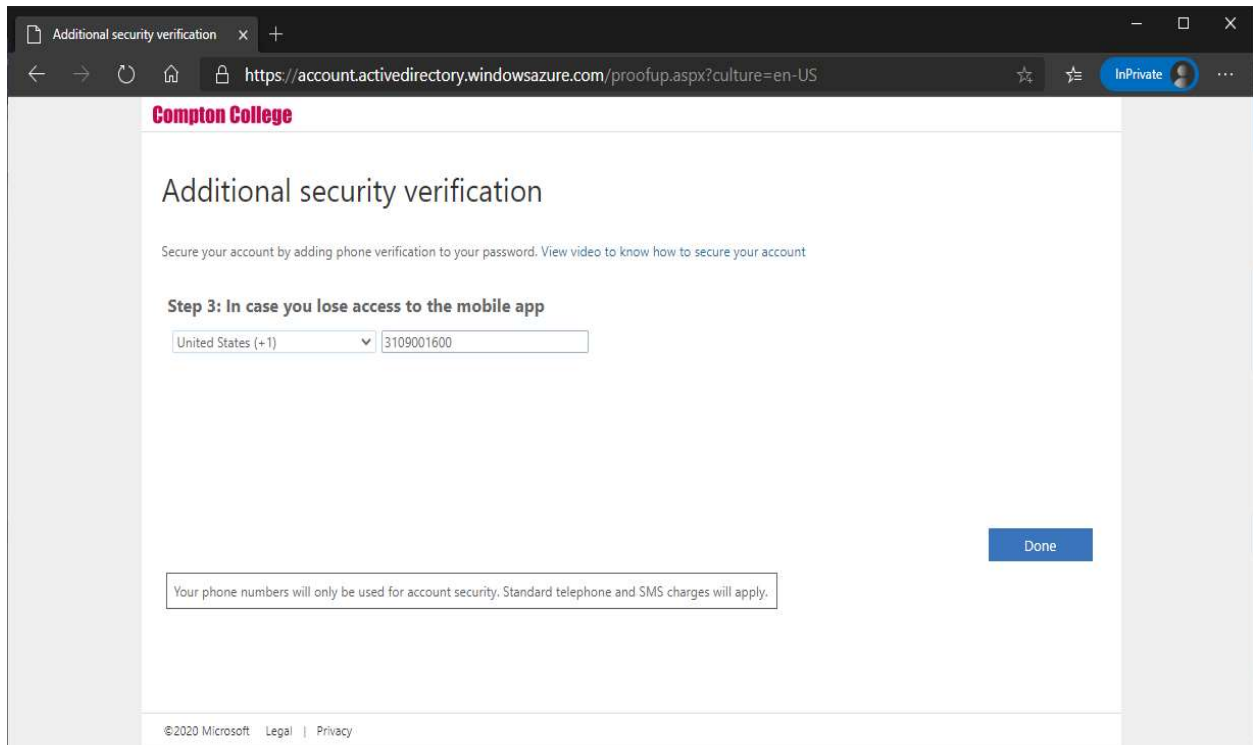


On your computer:
