- Role models for K-12 and other prospective students.
- Members of a group of extraordinary people some of the finest students that Compton College has to offer.
- Representatives of Compton College on and off the clock.
- You are expected to go beyond what is typically expected of you.
- Provide welcoming services.

Position Description

- Staff the open computer lab in the Transfer and Career Center to assist students with completing the steps to enrollment, navigate MyCompton, schedule counseling appointments when on campus or virtually via Cranium Café, Zoom, email, and phone when working remotely.
- Travel to and attend off campus fairs and other outreach events at local high schools and in the community.
- Conduct campus tours for new and prospective students and community members.
- Attend and/or conduct Compton College information sessions, application workshops and assist students with registration for courses.
- Assist Outreach and Educational Partnerships staff with other work as assigned.
- Must check the MyCompton portal, Cranium Café, and @compton.edu email daily.
- Pay is \$15.00/hour with a maximum of 40 hours per month (approximately 10 per week).

Job Requirements

- Maintain full-time enrollment status (12 units per fall and spring semesters).
- Maintain a minimum 2.5 <u>cumulative</u> GPA at Compton College.
- Eligible for Federal Work Study (FWS) or CalWORKs.
- Have reliable transportation, must be able to travel to off-site locations.
 - o Valid California Driver's License is required to receive mileage reimbursement.
- Must be able to work evenings and weekends.
- Laptop/Desktop.
- Internet Access.

- 1. Cover Letter.
- 2. Resume.
- 3. Unofficial Compton College (or high school for incoming freshman) transcripts.
- 4. Current class schedule.
- 5. Availability Sheet provided when interview is scheduled.
- 6. Present the first 10 Admissions Application slides
 - o Slides will be provided when interview is scheduled
 - You will be asked to present during the interview
